



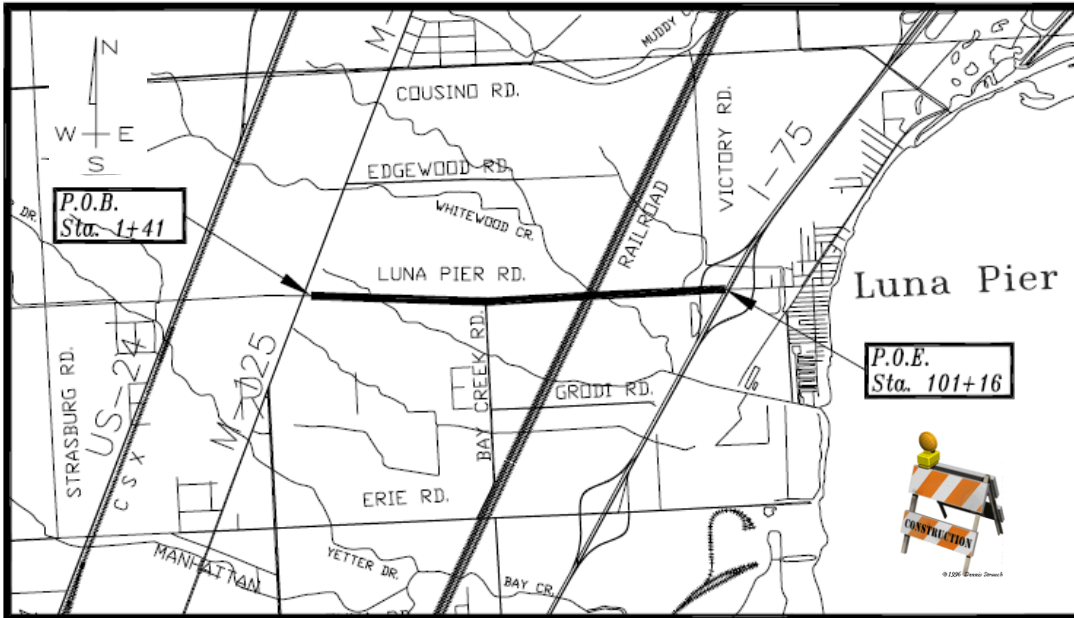

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

During construction Luna Pier Road will remain open to traffic but it will be closed down to one lane, two way traffic, controlled by flaggers during working hours. Traffic in one direction will be held back by flaggers until the opposing traffic passes then the held traffic will be permitted to proceed. During working hours expect long delays while on Luna Pier Road when in the construction zone.

How Can I Help?

Please drive safely and protect the workers. Taking alternate routes helps to speed the roadwork and reduces your delays through the construction zone.

What Is Being Done?

The Monroe County Road Commission in cooperation with Erie Township, the Michigan Department of Transportation and the Federal Highway Administration will be resurfacing Luna Pier Road from just east of M-125 to the bridge deck over I-75. This work is part of the nationwide American Recovery and Reinvestment Act and is a preventive maintenance project to preserve the Luna Pier Road pavement. The road surface will be milled off and a new surface repaved.

When Will This Be Done?

Construction is scheduled to begin June 7, 2010, weather permitting, and is expected to take one to two weeks to complete.
