- Met with Chief of Police about citizen concerns; he assures us that when there are any patterns of crime that cause concern he will use the newsletter or mailings to communicate with residents. The felonies of recent were not of a serious nature that would cause any kind of threat to the community. He has concerns about posting things in the Monroe Evening News as it puts Luna Piers business out there for misinterpretation, which could make the community look unattractive to potential citizens. Also there is some concern about making public information about arrests that are not convictions. He said the number one problem now is kids out after curfew; parents need to keep a close track on their kids.
- **Here are the 3 laws concerning the Michigan State curfew:**
 - * Under 12 years old MUST be off the streets between 10:00 pm – 6:00am
 - * Between the ages of 12 – 15 MUST be off the streets between midnight and 6:00am
 - * Any person of the age of 16 years or over assisting, aiding, abetting, allowing, permitting or encouraging any minor under the age of 16 years to violate the provisions of section 1 and 2 herof is guilty of a misdemeanor.
- I will be posting the curfew information in the next newsletter.
- Met with the Fire Chief concerning the desire to add a garage to the Fire Hall and he has some grant possibilities, therefore it is important that we provide matching funds.
