- Meet with CEO's of Consumers discuss negotiation
- Talked with Kate Ebli who spoke with a PR rep of Consumer's they told her that the tax department of Consumer's sent the tribunal letter on their own and that Consumer's has no intention of closing the Whiting Plant in the near future. Also confirmed that they are looking for a reduction in property taxes to help in the economic situation the company is experiencing. Kate offered to set up a meeting with Consumer's & the City and she would attend.

June 28, met with Butler the City Insurance Broker's

- We are experiencing a healthcare crisis as we have 34% of retirees in comparison to active employees on our health insurance. They received refusal letters from; Principal, Nippon and Humana
- Paramount, our current carrier, refused as well but the broker reminded them that they were aware of the % of retiree's when they took us as clients 3 years ago. They are reconsidering with a 7% increase in premiums.
- Some things are included in the employee contracts, which if approved, with hopefully encourage some improvement in this situation.
- Tax credit for less than 25 employees who still are paying for retiree insurance. Savings is off the payroll taxes
