- Working with Dr. Chapello to resolve the turning over of the Luna Pier Clinic to the City. Appears from a document found in the safe that the Doctor is currently leasing the building from the Luna Pier Community Improvement Association, Incorporation, which is a non-profit group. The President of this nonprofit organization was Clyde Evans. An investigation of how to proceed is already in motion. FYI Irene Urban, Dr. Chapello's sister passed away last week.
