Council Concerns

- Concealed pistol class was held Saturday September 13 & 14th. The class room portion was held Saturday at the fire hall. 10 students attended, 8 of which were residents of Luna Pier. The group patronized Ganders for lunch on Saturday. The hands on portion was held at the firing range on Sunday. The instructor collected \$10 from each student which was placed in the general fund. Each student and instructor signed a waiver according to city & police policy. The instructor suggested that if the fire department wanted to make some money that at future classes they could provide a simple hotdog lunch for participants. Future classes are scheduled in Oct. & Nov.

Meetings & Issues

- Met with Cindy Zohn about the Beautification Committee; opportunity for a Community Garden next summer. If there is enough interest we may consider it.
- Shoreline Protection Meeting well attended and extremely positive and productive. I recommend a letter writing campaign to our representatives continuing to remind them of our concerns and asking for the support they offered. Also I would like to hold another Shoreline Townhall Meeting Oct 3, 2008 at 7:00PM to appoint a 2 representatives from each area of the City; South lake, Venice Canals, in land, Harold Dr lake & Allens Cove, one from North end and one from the South end. These 10 people along with Chris Heid, Greg Stewart and myself will look at the challenges the shoreline faces, set priorities and make a plan that will be submitted to Council for action. At the townhall I would like the newly formed committee to set a date for their first meeting. I will send letters to all residents inviting them to attend.
- Court case Mary Liske vs Jack Campbell was adjourned until October 22, 2008 9:00 a.m. so his lawyer can become familiar with his case.
- Administrator Stewart's evaluation is complete.
